# **Parliament Session Alert**

Budget Session: February 23 – May 13, 2016

## **Highlights**

- ◆ The Budget Session of Parliament will be held between February 23, 2016 and May 13, 2016. The session will have a recess from March 17 to April 24, when the Standing Committees will examine the Demand for Grants of various ministries. There will be a total of 31 sittings.
- ◆ The President will address Parliament on February 23. The Railway Budget will be presented on February 25 and the Union Budget on February 29.
- ◆ The agenda for legislation includes 12 Bills for consideration and passing. Four Bills including the Finance Bill, 2016 are listed for introduction, consideration and passing. The government plans to introduce two new Bills. Two Bills will be withdrawn. We list these below:
