## Monsoon Session: July 18 – August 12, 2016

### **Highlights**

- Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha will meet for the Monsoon Session between July 18 and August 12, 2016. There will be a total of 20 sittings.
- The agenda for legislation includes nine Bills for consideration and passing. Six Bills are listed for introduction, consideration and passing. We list these below:
